

CIRCULAR -13/2014

Sub : On-line Vehicle Token System for Export Vehiclereg

This is to inform that as an e-freight initiative at CSIA, MIAL is introducing On-line Vehicle Token Generation through web-portal www.gmax.gvk.com effective 10th November 2014.

All concerned are hereby advised to make note of the following effective 10th Nov 2014 for export operations and vehicle lane management system.

1. Export TSP will be printed only on successful generation of vehicle token in the system.
2. Vehicle token slip will be part of the TSP receipt printed at the footer of the receipt.
3. Without Vehicle Token export trucks will not be allowed to join the lane.
4. Single TSP can be attached with single vehicle or multiple vehicles.
5. Multiple TSP can be attached with single vehicle.
6. All vehicles carrying same shipment i.e single TSP to be queued together.
7. CARR Message (TDG) cannot be done without the association of vehicle token to the TSP.
8. Multiple TSP with multiple Vehicle Token is not possible for generation.
9. Each vehicle will have unique vehicle token number with bar-code.
10. Time stamp scanning at the various stages of the export vehicle will be implemented in the second phase.
